**Lennox Thomas** - Psychoanalytic Psychotherapist. Author, Trainer and Supervisor. Lennox will present and discuss his latest paper **The Significance of Fathers**.

The paper '**The Significance of Fathers**' was written as a result of many years working with men in therapy, and later women who had problematic relations with fathers. Lennox was curious about what the literature had to say about the father's relationship with his children as well as the male therapist with his patients.

Lennox is Consultant Psychotherapist at the Refugee Therapy Centre, he has a small private practice and is a training therapist and supervisor. Lennox is an Honorary Fellow of the UKCP.

Lennox's career began after training in child care, child development, working in a children's home and later in a hospital with neonates and parents. Newly acquainted with the work of Donald Winnicott and John Bowlby he attended seminars with Clare Winnicott. Lennox trained in child and family psychotherapy in the 1970's before training in psychoanalytic psychotherapy at the BAP. He worked in the Probation Service for many years before his appointment as Clinical Director of Nafsiyat, the intercultural therapy centre. Having academic connections with UCL he was made Co-Director of the UCL Msc in Intercultural Psychotherapy.
